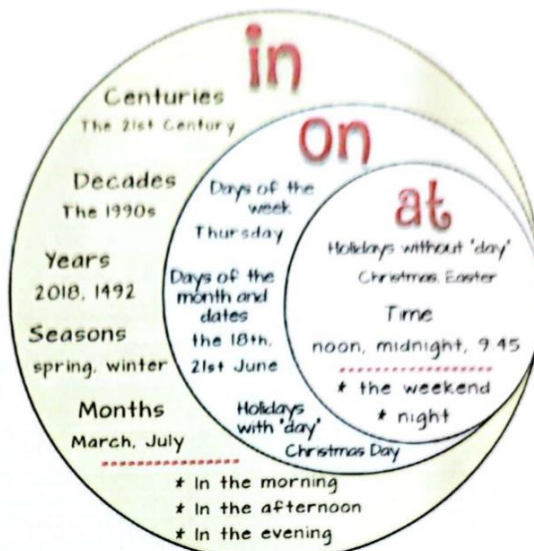

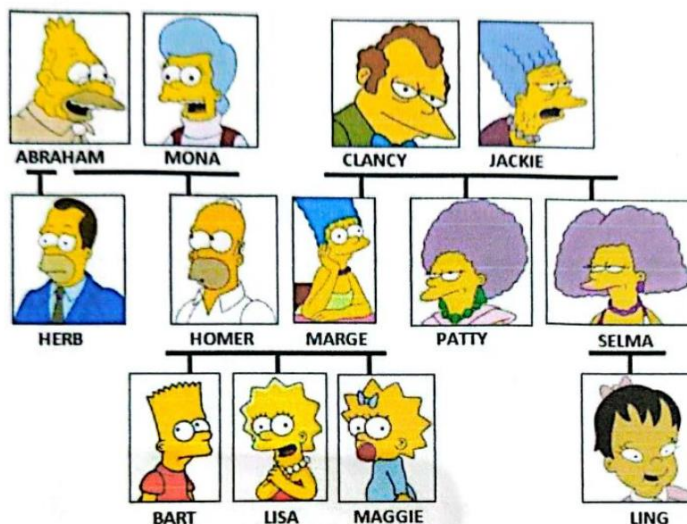

Eminem became popular in 1999 with his album The Slim Shady LP, which won a Grammy Award for Best Rap Album.

The following album, The Marshall Mathers LP, became the fastest-selling hip hop album in history.

The Marshall Mathers LP and his third album, The Eminem Show, also won Grammy Awards, and in 2002.

He won the Academy Award for Best Original Song for a song in the film 8 Mile. He was the actor in the movie too.

He has made his last album, Relapse, on May 15, 2009. Eminem sold more than 75 million albums in the world, and in the United States is the best selling music artist of the 2000s.

Eminem is also ranked in the 100 Greatest Artists of All Time by Rolling Stone magazine.

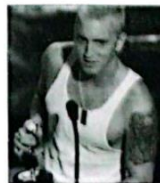

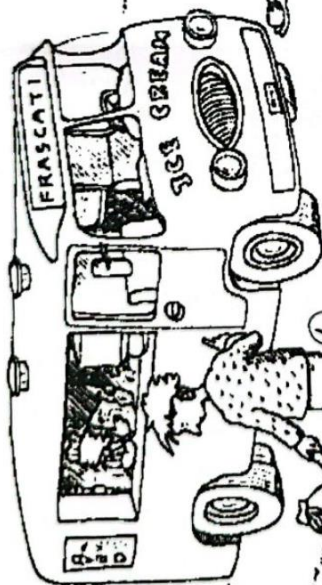

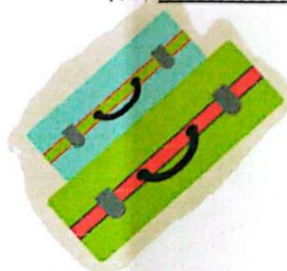
